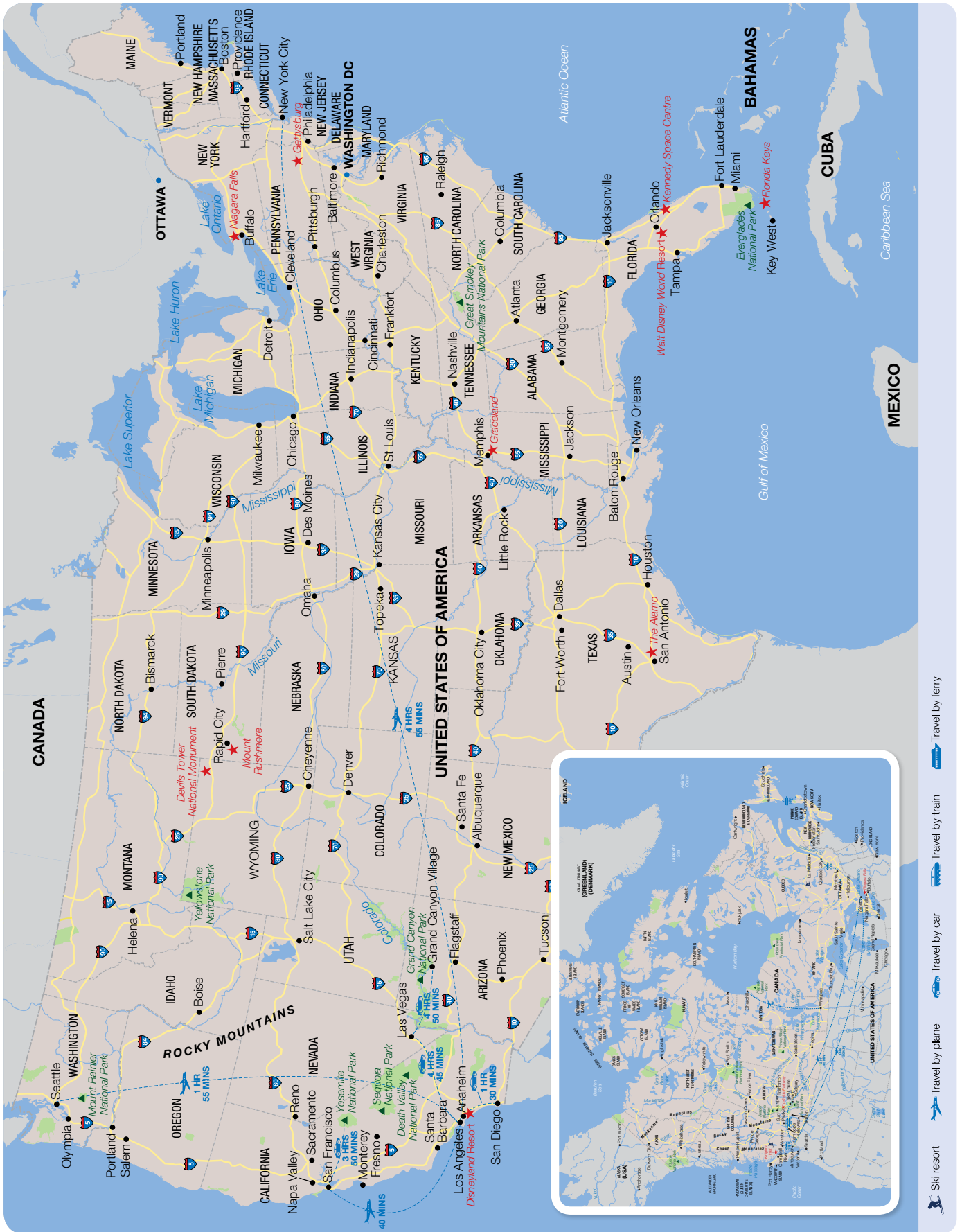

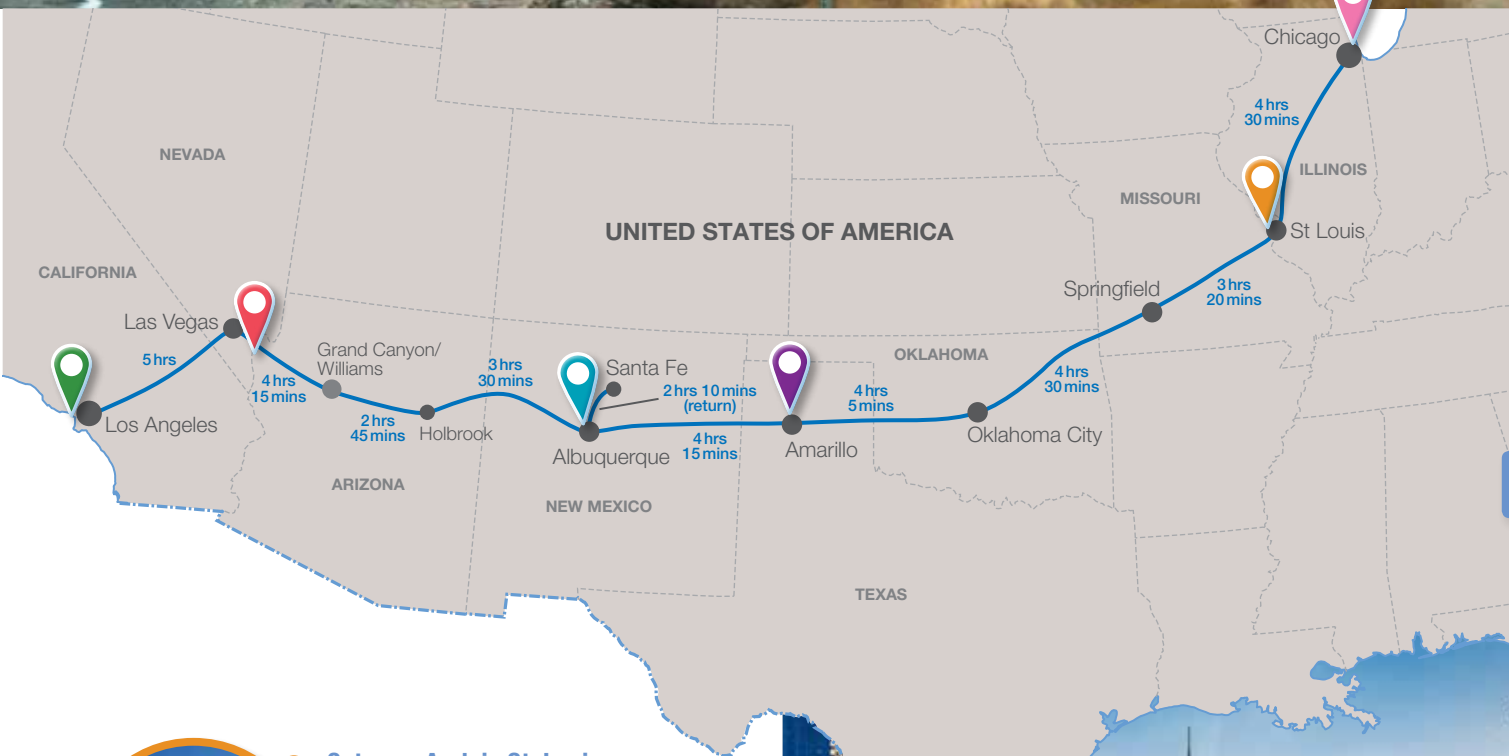

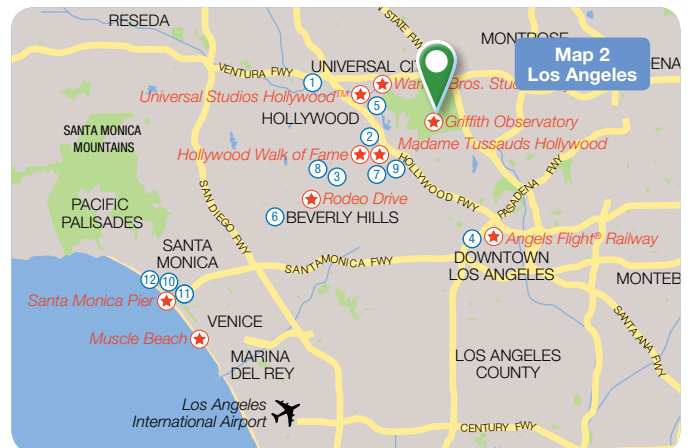
## Fortress of Solitude – San Francisco

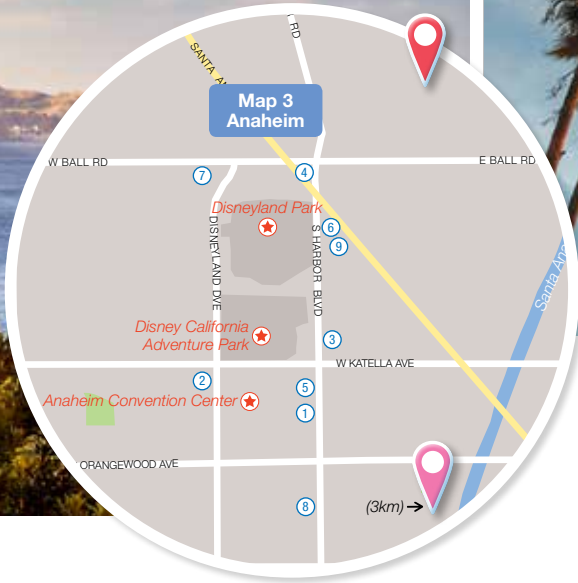
## Sports Lover

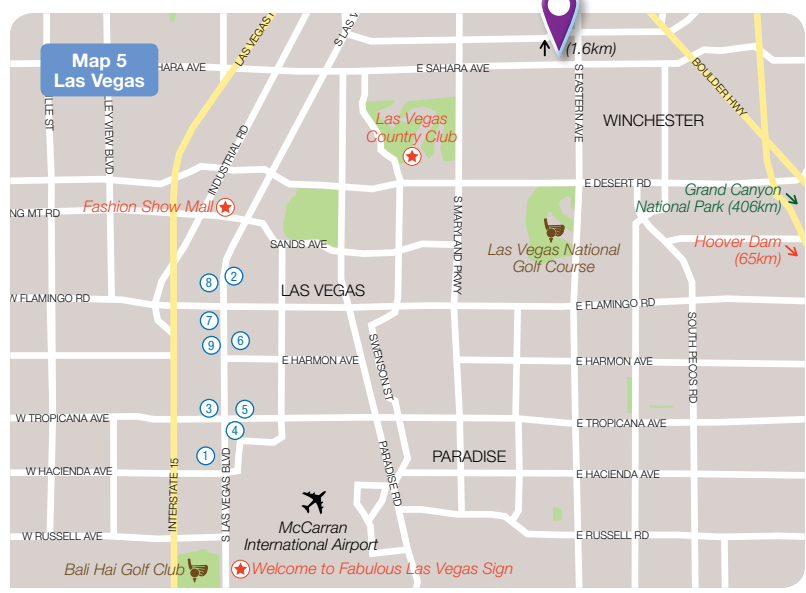

## WHEN TO GO

There's never a bad time to visit the USA West Coast, as you'll find sunny days year-round in California.

The middle of summer (July to August) can get extremely hot in Las Vegas, but the casinos are all air-conditioned, and the Grand Canyon, despite being in the desert, gets snow each winter (January to March).

## TIME

California, Nevada, Washington state and Oregon (Pacific Coast Time) are 20–21 hours behind New Zealand, depending on Daylight Saving Time, which is observed from mid-March to early-November. Arizona and Utah follow Mountain Standard Time (1 hour earlier), but do not observe Daylight Saving Time.

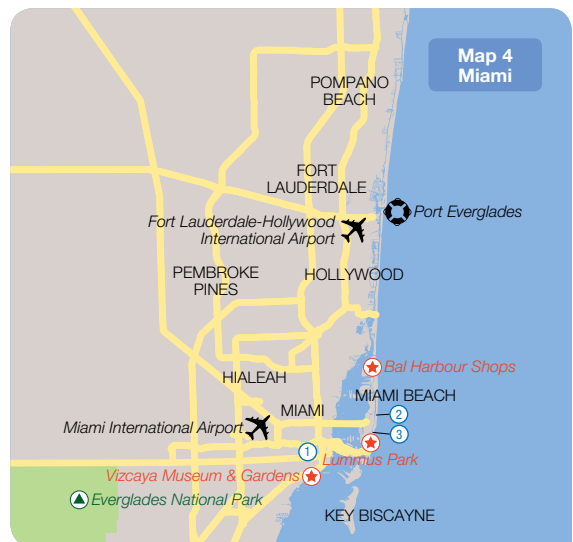
