#### Day 07: Valletta

# Glossary

## Clarifying the intricacies of a small ship cruise with APT.

## a

## **Adaptors & Electricity**

The electrical outlets onboard Le Bouganville, in the suites and public areas, are 220V – 2 round pin European socket & 110V – 2 flat pin US socket.

On board MV Queen Eleganza, the electrical outlets in suites and public areas, are 220V – 2 round pin European socket.

The use of personal hairdryers (there is a hairdryer in your suite), clothing irons, curling tongs, etc. in your cabin is strictly forbidden as they may damage the ships' electrical system. Outlets can charge camera batteries and iPad's, tablets, etc. however; you will need to bring an adaptor.

## Allergies

If you have a food allergy or another condition that needs to be managed on tour, please advise your booking agent as soon as possible, as well as your cruise director upon arrival, as most suppliers require advance notice to accommodate this. In some cases you might be asked to fill out a form

## Air Conditioning & Heating

All suites on board our small ships have individual climate control for your comfort.

## **Bedding Configuration**

Most cabins, staterooms and suites can be configured as either double or twin share. Please be aware some cabins only allow for twin or double bedding. Please refer to the deck plans and enquire at the time of booking.

## Beverages

On your ship, coffee and tea are available free of charge throughout the day. A selection of complimentary alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages are available all day throughout your cruise. French Champagne, premium spirits and selected wines are offered at an additional cost.

During land journeys, complimentary water, tea and coffee are offered during included meals. On select evenings, complimentary alcoholic beverages will also be included with your dinner.

## **Butler Service**

A Butler service is reserved for passengers travelling in suites on Deck 6 aboard Le Bougainville. Your Butler will look after every aspect of your well-being and be available to fulfil all of your expectations.

## **Cabin Entertainment**

Each cabin is equipped with a Flat Screen TV with satellite service (when available).

## Currency

The currency on board both Le Bougainville and MV Queen Eleganza is the Euro. For your convenience, all purchases and paid services on board are billed to your shipboard account. At the end of your cruise you will receive a total that can be paid with cash or credit card. The ships do not accept payment made by Diners Club cards, prepaid Visa or MasterCard Debit cards, EFTPOS, Travelex cards, cash passports or travellers cheques. Onboard Queen Eleganza, your shipboard account can be settled with cash in Euro or Croatian Kuna. Credit or Debit cards will incur a surcharge of up to 4%. Local currency on shore will vary depending on itinerary and countries visited. For more information, enquire at time of booking. For the most up-to-date exchange rate, please check with your bank.

## Dining

All meals on board your cruise are included.

Onboard Le Bougainville, meals are served in the Grill Restaurant or Gastronomic Restaurant. It is not necessary to make reservations in the main restaurants. On board, enjoy a full buffet breakfast each morning in the main restaurant. Lunch consists of salads, soups, and a choice of entrées, mains and desserts. Dinner is a multi-course meal presenting a selection of entrées, mains and desserts. Casual dining is also available, as is 24-hour room service.

Onboard MV Queen Eleganza, meals are served in the dining room in open seat dining. Casual alfresco dining is also available (weather permitting). Complimentary self-service tea and coffee, with fruit and biscuits, are available 24 hours a day. On land journeys, a buffet breakfast is included each day. Select lunches and dinners are included as indicated on itinerary pages.

Vegetarian and gluten-free options are available. Please notify APT of any special dietary requirements when making your booking.

## **Dress Code**

The dress code is relaxed. Light, comfortable clothing is ideal for during the day, but smart casual clothing for evenings on board the ship is recommended. You may wish to bring something a little dressier for the welcome and farewell dinners and any special events. Comfortable footwear is imperative, as some excursions involve walking steps or ramps to embark/ disembark. If your sightseeing includes churches, monasteries, synagogues or mosques, dress casually, but keep your clothes clean and ensure sufficient body cover (for example cover your shoulders and wear trousers or a knee-length dress).

An elevator is located on Le Bougainville. MV Queen Eleganza does not have lift, with decks only accessible by stairs.

Due to poor weather and/or venue closures on some dates, some options may not be available as listed. For your convenience, most options will be booked while on tour with your APT cruise director, who will be able to provide you with further information. If your first choice of option is unavailable, you may be asked to choose an alternative. Please see pages 74-75 for further details.

## Gratuities

Gratuities are included for all cruise staff, local guides and drivers on all small ship cruises and land journeys. Gratuities cannot be redeemed for a cash refund.

## Hotels

The official check-in time at most hotels in Europe is 3pm local time but where possible, the hotel will try to have your room available earlier. If your flight arrives in the morning, luggage can be dropped off at the hotel before check-in and delivered to your room later. You will be required to present a credit card upon check-in to cover incidentals. If you do not have a credit card, a monetary deposit in local currency may be required. Amounts differ for each hotel. Normal check-out times vary, but are usually at 11am or noon. If you have a late afternoon or evening flight, most hotels have a luggage room where you can store your luggage until you depart for the airport.

## Housekeeping

Onboard Le Bouganville, our housekeeping staff will attend to your suite twice daily – once during the day and again with a turndown service in the evening. Reception can be contacted 24 hours a day for any additional housekeeping requests. On the MV Queen Eleganza, you are kindly requested to hang out the 'Please clean my cabin' sign whilst you are at breakfast, in order for the ship's housekeeper to enter your cabin.

## Internet & Wi-Fi

Internet is available on board, with Wi-Fi available in most areas. Internet access on board the ship is not guaranteed at all times due to the nature of satellite communications, which are subject to weather and other disruptions. Le Bougainville's lounge also has computers to review digital photographs taken on your journey. There are no printers available for use.

## Language

The official language used by APT staff worldwide is English. All staff, crew and local guides speak fluent English. Le Bougainville is crewed by French company Ponant, and therefore all crew members also speak French. For your convenience all guided tours, announcements and lectures will be presented in English.

## Laundry

Laundry services are available and price lists will be available in your suite. Clothes cannot be dry-cleaned on board. Selfservice laundry facilities are not available on board. For safety reasons, it is not permitted to use an iron in your suite.

## Library

Le Bougainville has a collection of books and games available for guests to borrow free of charge.

## Lounges

Le Bougainville features two large comfortably furnished lounge areas where you can relax and unwind. The main lounge also serves as a gathering place for port talks, lectures and entertainment. The MV Queen Eleganza offers an intimate lounge on the Upper Deck.

## Luggage

As a general rule, airlines permit passengers in economy class to take one piece of luggage that does not exceed 160cm, or weigh more than 20kg. We advise you to contact your airline carrier or travel agent for specific information prior to departure, as size and weight limitations may vary. Each passenger is entitled to take one piece of luggage on your cruise that does not exceed the above specifications. Please limit your hand luggage to one bag that fits under your aircraft seat or in the overhead compartment. You will receive an APT travel bag with your documentation, which we recommend you use.

## Medical

Le Bouganville has an onboard doctor and infirmary.

There is no doctor on board MV Queen Eleganza. Should you be in need of medical assistance, please contact a member of the crew who are first aid trained, or the cruise director. In case of emergency during the night, an emergency call button is available in your cabin. Due to the ship sailing close to the shore, medical personnel can be summoned aboard quickly.

Passengers are responsible for all charges that result from visiting either the onboard medical practitioner or a local medical facility. It is also your responsibility to carry all medication for the tour duration.

## **Overnight or Late Departure**

Represented by the symbol, ships will stay in port either overnight or until 10pm.

## **Physical Fitness**

APT tours are not physically demanding but do require a reasonable level of health and fitness. The nature of these cruises requires regular embarkation/disembarkation of Zodiac boats and/or local tender craft for shore access, as well as wet landings on occasion, dependant on your itinerary. Passengers must be able to climb ramps and steps and step in and out of smaller vessels. Some tours visit remote areas and feature activities with varying degrees of difficulty, therefore it is vital to select a tour with an activity level suited to your health and fitness. Walking tours are often on uneven ground and may include steep inclines. You should be able to stand for an extended period of time to visit museums and attractions, as well as when checking in for flights and cruises and at Customs and Immigration.

## **Room service**

Room Service is available 24 hours a day to all suites and staterooms on Le Bouganville. Room service is not available on MV Queen Eleganza.

## Signature Experiences

Signature Experiences are included for all guests as indicated in itineraries.

## Smoking

Smoking is not permitted anywhere inside any of our ships, including on balconies in your suite. Smoking is only permitted in designated outdoor areas. The same policy applies for electronic cigarettes.

## Swimming

On Deck 6 of Le Bougainville, you will find a heated pool. If itinerary, weather and sea conditions permit, there may be opportunities to swim from local beaches or straight from the MV Queen Eleganza, all at the Captain's discretion.

## Telephone

Aboard Le Bougainville, all suites are equipped with a telephone. It can be used to call between suites as well as from ship to shore. As the telephone system functions via satellite there may be times, depending on routing, when the phones are out of range. Please note this service will incur additional charges.

## Tenders

Tenders are small local vessels used to ferry passengers to and from the ship when we are unable to dock in port and are therefore anchored just of the coast. The use of tenders will be dependent on your cruise itinerary.

## Theatre

The theatre on board Le Bougainville is a space where passengers can gather for events and lectures by naturalists, lecturers, experienced guides and specialists. By night guests can enjoy entertainment including musical performances, film screenings and theatrical performances.


## Transfers
