

# ITINERARY

## DAY 1: Arrival in Bangkok (D)

Upon arrival at Bangkok, your local English-speaking guide and driver will pick you up and accompany you to the hotel.

## DAY 2: Day in Bangkok (B,L)

Visit two of the most important sights of Bangkok: the Reclining Buddha at Wat Pho is a giant lying Buddha, covered in gold leaf. The Grand Palace is a “must see” for every visitor. Located close to the banks of the Chao Phraya River the Grand Palace is the perfect example of an ancient Siamese court. Within the compound is the Temple of Emerald Buddha (Wat Pra Kaew), Lunch will be served in a Thai restaurant. Travel on the Chao Phraya River (The River of Kings) and on through the Klongs (canals) of Thonburi.

You will have the chance to observe and photograph the serene family homes and temples along the waterways, which gave the city the name “Venice of the East”. You will also pay a visit to one of the most photographed sights in Bangkok, the Wat Arun. The majestic shrine has a pagoda of 76 m high. It is decorated with glazed ceramic pieces, that reflect the rising sun and gave the temple its name.

Important: Please note that you are required to wear proper attire (no bare shoulder, bare knees or strapless-heel shoes). Shoes must be removed before entering all temple buildings.

## DAY 3: Bangkok – Trip to the floating market (B)

To discover the way Bangkok used to be, travel approximately 100 km outside of Bangkok to the Damnoen Saduak Floating Market with its many colours, flavours and exotic fragrances. Start with a scenic ride on a narrow longtail – speedboat, passing riverside villages and fruit plantations, before entering the vibrant market. There will be many photo opportunities along the way and on the colourful market on the water.

## DAY 4: Bangkok – Chiang Mai (B)

Arrive in Chiang Mai and transfer to visit Wat Phrathat Doi Suthep, the sacred temple with a challenging flight of steps which are flanked by Naga Serpents. Wat Chedi Luang, is the site of a formerly massive pagoda that was unfortunately destroyed in the great earthquake of 1545; Wat Phra Singh, the lovely Lai Kam chapel houses the revered Phra Singh Buddha image. Then transfer to check in at the hotel.

## DAY 5: Baan Chang Elephant Park (B)

A Half-Day Elephant's Heaven allows visitors to get to know each of the remarkable elephants and gain a special understanding of their daily lives and behaviours.

Pick up from hotel in Chiang Mai at 06.30–07.00 AM

Activities: Feeding, Roaming, Herbal Medicine, observing and join them bathing

PLEASE NOTE: At the Park, we will allow you to spend as much time as possible with the elephants. Therefore, there is no formal schedule aside from pick-up times

Visit Pileh Lagoon where you can swim and jump in crystal clear water. Visit Viking Cave and see ancient cave paintings and thousands of swallows

living on the top of the high ledges. Visit the hidden cove of Ao Ling or Monkey Beach.
