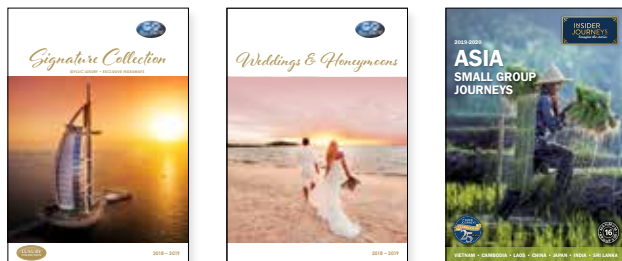

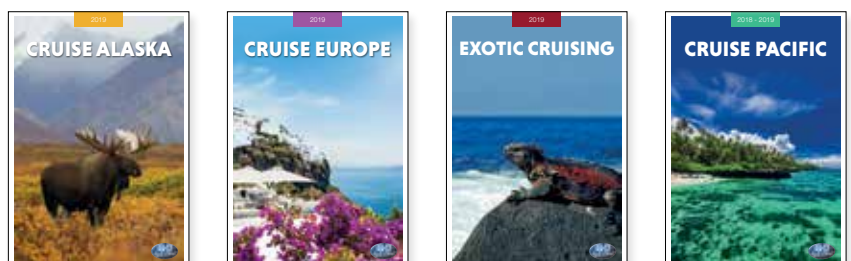

When to Go

Hong Kong has a subtropical climate with distinct seasons. It can be visited year-round. The warmest months are from late May to September. The cooler, dryer winter months are from December to February. Some shops close for the Chinese New Year that runs from mid-January to February. For a less expensive holiday, avoid travelling around Chinese national holidays.

Macau has a tropical climate and the weather is generally hot and humid.

China has variable weather conditions due to its size. Spring and autumn offer a pleasant climate with beautiful blooming flowers and autumn hues, while May to August in the centre and north can be hot. This summer period can be busy because it is a peak travel time for Chinese families and students on holidays. Snowfall can occur in the north from December to March, but this time can be better value with stunning scenery.

Golden Week

China has three Golden Weeks in January/February, April/May and October. During these times, attractions are at least three times busier than at other peak times, hotels are often booked out, and train and air tickets are in high demand.

Visas & Passports

A valid passport with at least six months' validity beyond the intended stay is required in Hong Kong, Macau and China. New Zealand passport holders do not require a visa for visits of up to 90 days in Hong Kong and 30 days in Macau. All visitors require a visa when travelling in China and this must be obtained before departing New Zealand. Travellers spending time in China as a stopover can apply for a 24, 72, or 144 hour Transit Visa. Travel advice is available from the New Zealand Government at www.safetravel.govt.nz.

Time

Hong Kong and China are both 5 hours behind New Zealand Standard Time (NZST).

Electricity

Hong Kong & Macau: 220-240V 50Hz. An adapter is required.
China: 220V 50Hz. An adapter is required.

Currency

Hong Kong: Hong Kong Dollar (HKD)

Macau: The Pataca (MOP)

China: Renminbi (RMB) Yuan (CNY)

Major credit cards are widely accepted and ATMs are widespread throughout Hong Kong and Macau.

Chinese currency is difficult to find outside of China, therefore USD or Australian currency is the best currency to take. Notes should be in good condition or they may not be exchanged. Most credit cards are accepted in hotels and major restaurants.

Tipping

Tipping is discretionary. As a guide, most restaurants in Hong Kong and Macau will levy a 10% service charge.

Language

Hong Kong: Cantonese and English are the official languages. Communicating with locals is easy as English is widely spoken.

Macau: Chinese and Portuguese are the official languages, with Cantonese and English being widely spoken.

China: Mandarin is the official language in China. There are also numerous dialects spoken throughout different parts of China, including Cantonese. English is becoming widely spoken in major cities.

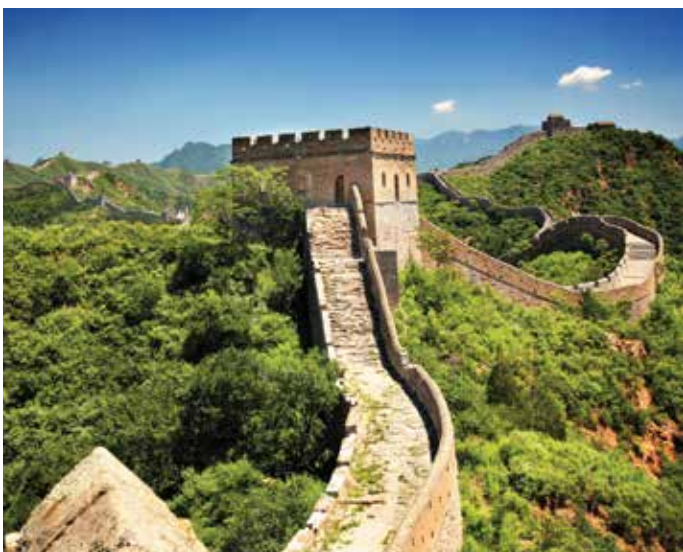
A Royal Tour

Delve into China's imperial past as you explore the incredible Forbidden City. Off limits to all but the Royal Family for 500 years, it now houses the Palace Museum. With more than 8700 rooms, it is the world's largest palace complex and contains the biggest collection of preserved ancient wooden structures found in any country.



Spot the Difference

Xian is home to the Army of Terracotta Warriors. The life-sized statues were unearthed in 1974 and they are now considered one of the most important archaeological finds of the last century. Take time to spot the differences between each of the 8000 intricately carved unique statues.



Walk the Wall

Walk into history as you take your first step onto the Great Wall of China. This ancient wonder, stretching for thousands of kilometres from the Yellow Sea to the Gobi Desert, is a historical marvel offering magnificent views of the surrounding area. Hong Kong Island

Hong Kong

Exotic, colourful and buzzing with people, Hong Kong is an unforgettable city that will stimulate the senses like no other. From its towering modern skyscrapers and sophisticated restaurants to its street-style markets and roadside food stalls, it's a fascinating place full of wonderful things to see and do. The spectacular harbour vistas, lofty mountain peaks and famous neon-lit alleys will wow you. The extravagant designer shopping malls and the bustling night markets will satisfy any shopping enthusiast. For another feast of the senses, take the hour-long ferry trip to Macau to experience its unique mix of Portuguese and Chinese cultures and of course, its famous Las Vegas-style casinos.

Hong Kong

Hong Kong is a story in three parts: Hong Kong Island, Kowloon Peninsula and the New Territories. Together, they're a combination of modern skyscrapers and ancient temples, vibrant markets, beaches, mountains and deserted islands. Then there is the shopping – designer fashion, technology and charming local souvenirs. It is also renowned as a gourmet's paradise, with an abundance of exceptional restaurants.

Originally a small fishing community and a haven for travellers and pirates, Hong Kong was used by the British as a naval base during the Opium Wars with China. It remained a British colony from 1842 until sovereignty was transferred to the People's Republic of China in 1997.

Kowloon

Kowloon is a bustling mixture of shops, fantastic bars, pubs, restaurants, gardens and markets. It is connected to Hong Kong Island by three tunnels and the MTR, but a trip across Victoria Harbour on a Star Ferry is the ideal way to commute. Be tempted by the Temple Street Night Markets and wander along Nathan Road for its vast range of shopping.

Lantau Island

Hong Kong's largest island, Lantau Island, is well known for its unspoilt countryside, lush green valleys, and the Giant Buddha. Take a tour of the famous Po Lin Monastery before climbing the 268 steps to view the seated outdoor bronze Buddha.

Hong Kong Island

Home to the original settlement of the Hong Kong territory, Hong Kong Island is the city's financial and business hub, full of charming colonial buildings and modern skyscrapers. The island has a plethora of restaurants, bars and shops. Visit the SoHo district for upscale boutiques, bars and a wide variety of restaurants. Travel on the tram car to Victoria Peak, pick up some souvenirs, artworks and fashion at Stanley Market or dine at one of the famous floating restaurants on Aberdeen Harbour. Every night the skyline dazzles with the 'A Symphony of Lights' neon light show synchronised to music.

- 7.4 To the extent that we are able to do so (bearing in mind we are dependent upon third party availability beyond our control) we will be pleased to incorporate any reasonable changes you request. An itinerary change may attract a fee similar to cancellation fees in Clause 7.2 above to cover our administration costs.
- 7.5 Some Suppliers may reserve the right to cancel or amend travel, accommodation, etc and GO Holidays must therefore reserve similar rights to cancel or amend any holiday arrangements.

- 7.6 There are cases where the terms of supply as to refundability of pre-payments require provisions different from the above. In those cases the conditions specific to your tour will be advised to you at the time your booking is processed.

8. Insurance

We strongly recommend that as a minimum you insure yourself fully against cancellation, disruption, loss of luggage and personal property, and medical expenses. Your travel agent will be able to provide you with further information.

9. Items Not Covered

Unless otherwise specified, the cost of meals, drinks, laundry, telephone calls, insurance, sightseeing tours, local taxes, airport departure taxes, aviation insurance levies and passport or visa application fees are not included.

10. Package Costs

Included in the tour costs are charges for normal booking procedure costs, communication costs, administration, research, printing, etc. Where the land arrangements of holidays are included in a composite package, an itemisation of costs will not be rendered.

11. Visas / Passports

For all holidays in this brochure you will require a valid passport. You are responsible for arranging your own passport, visa and health requirements (including inoculation where applicable). You should check with your travel agent who will be able to provide you with the necessary information.

12. Non-Use of Services or Facilities

If, of your own choice, you decide not to use part or parts of the arranged services or facilities, you will not be entitled to a refund from us (provided we have carried out our service with reasonable skill and care and to your requirements) and you may not be entitled to a refund from any Supplier.

13. GO Holidays Charter for Addressing Problems

In the event that you should strike a problem or you are dissatisfied with some aspect of the services or facilities during the course of your trip, our recommendation is that you take the matter up directly with the supplier of the service at the time, or as soon as practicable in the circumstances. This provides the opportunity to have the matter discussed and investigated on the spot and a remedy negotiated then and there to enable you to continue enjoying your holiday. We have found from experience that it is very difficult (in some countries impossible) for us to obtain redress for you once travel has been completed. If this does not work, we wish to be involved at the earliest possible moment and our commitment is that we will immediately work on resolving the issue to your satisfaction.

14. Health or Disability

Some Suppliers may reserve the right to refuse to carry or accommodate people who, because of a health condition or disability, may require services or facilities to be provided in a special manner or at a certain stage of pregnancy. You should check this with your travel agent.

15. Legal Claims

The laws of New Zealand will govern any claims or legal action in connection with the provision of our services to you. Any claim or legal action against the Suppliers is likely to be subject to the terms of your contract with them, and may be governed by the laws of other countries.
