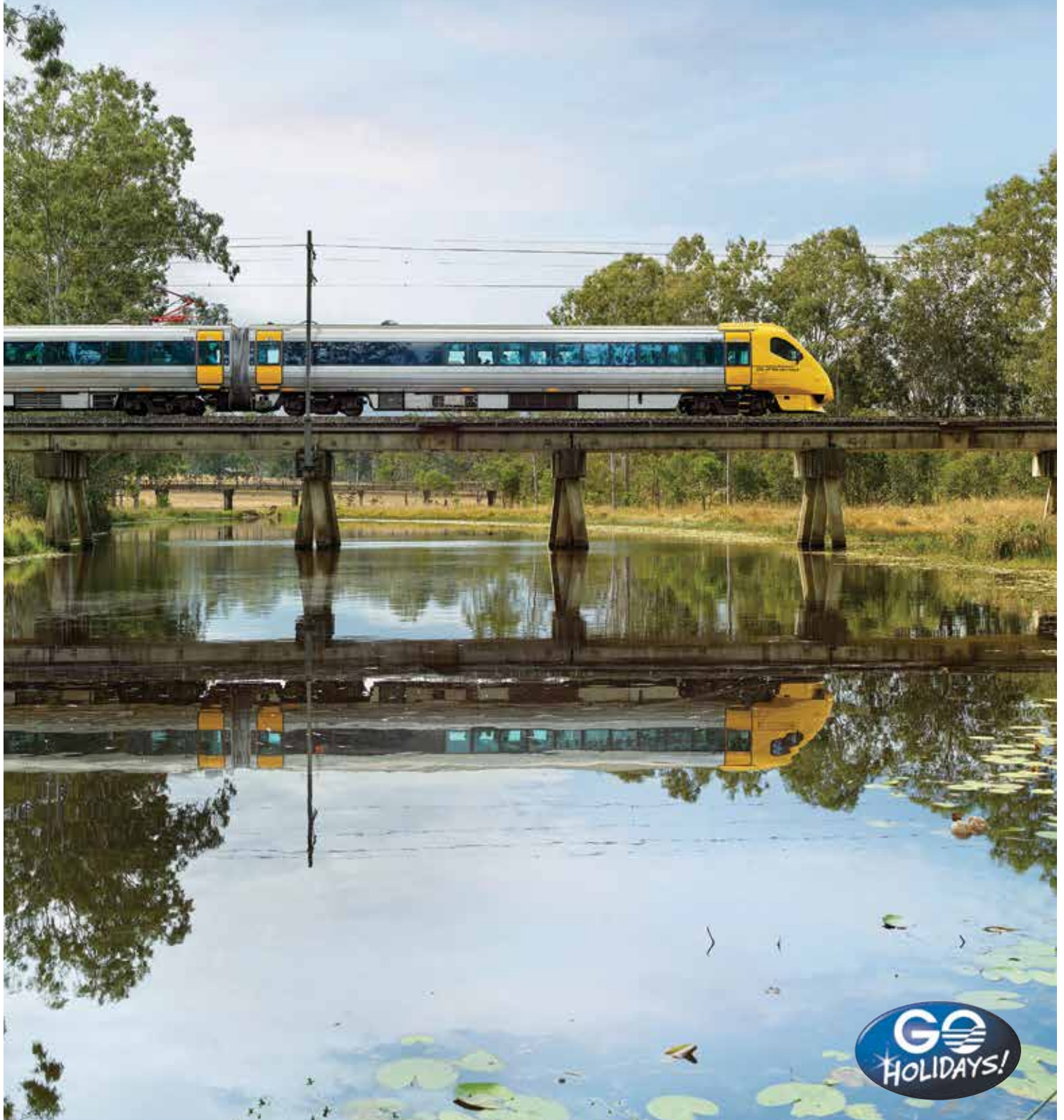

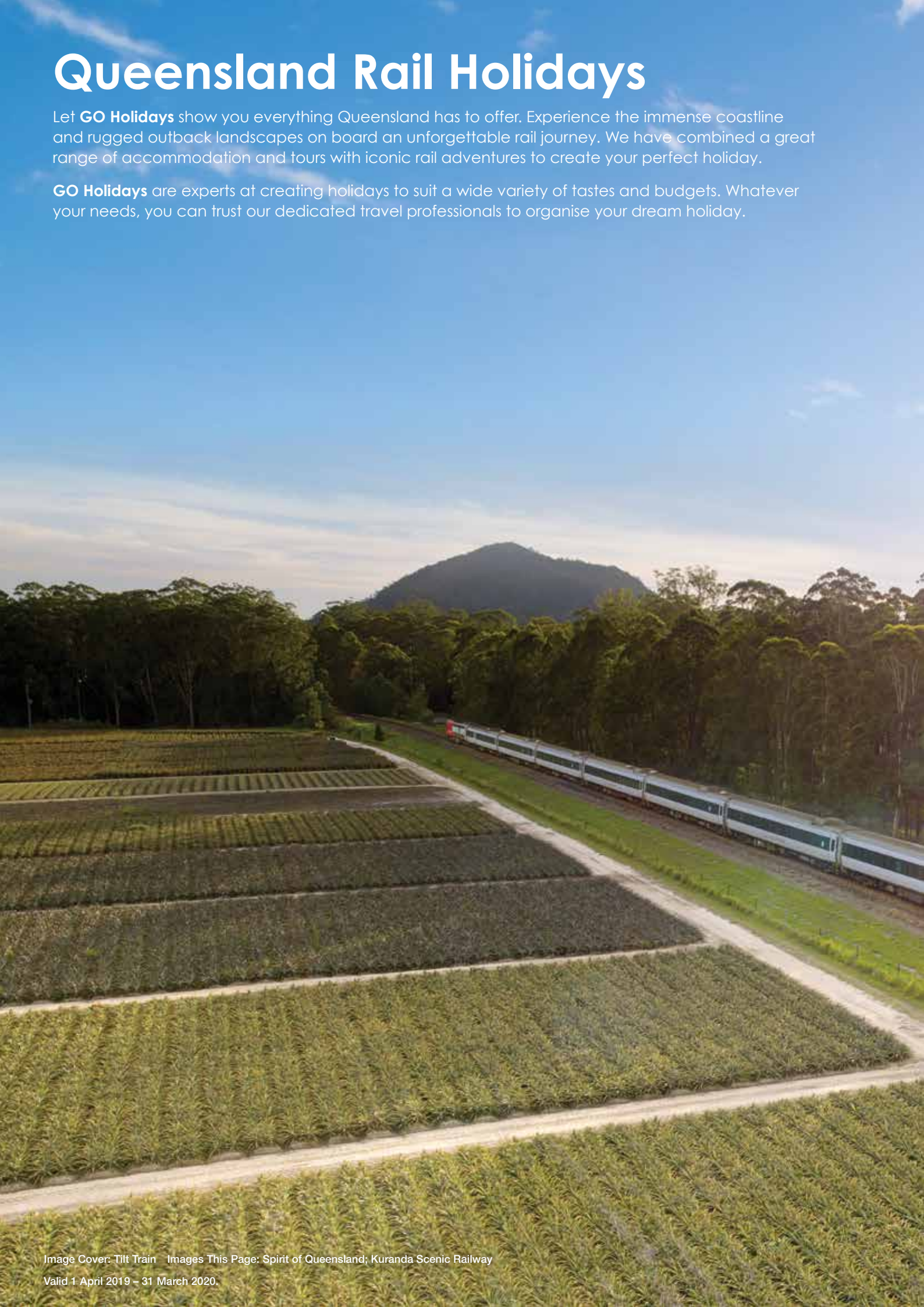

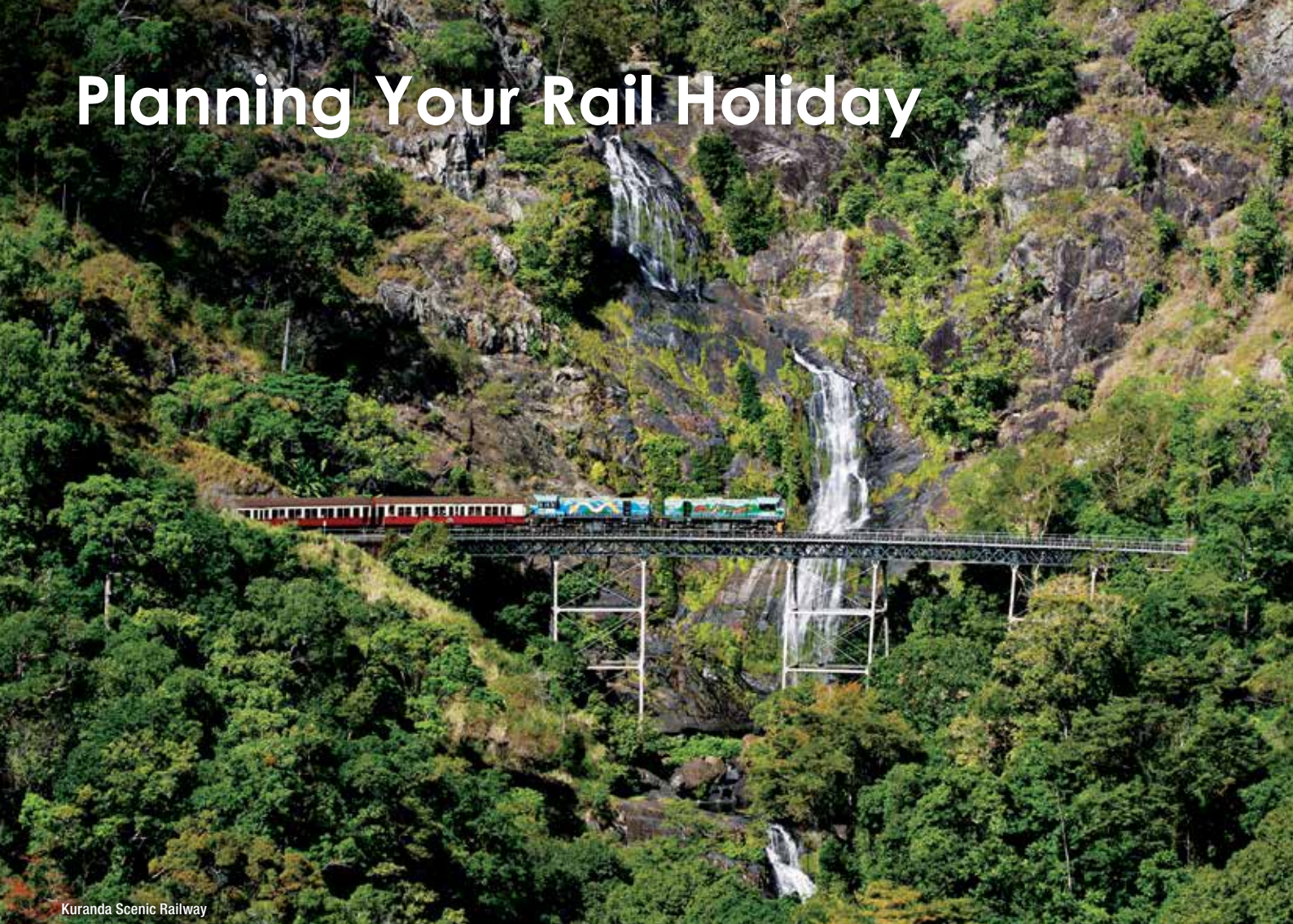

### Fraser Coast

Take the Tilt Train to the sleepy town of Hervey Bay, the gateway to the world's largest sand island, Fraser Island. Wander through towering, ancient rainforests and swim in pristine freshwater lakes. Drive along endless Seventy Five Mile Beach and discover the Maheno Shipwreck.

### Southern Great Barrier Reef & Capricorn Coast

Bundaberg is the starting point to the Southern Great Barrier Reef and is only a 15 minute drive from the seaside town of Bargara. See the turtles of Mon Repos lay their eggs from November to January or from January to March, watch the hatchlings make their way to the ocean.

## 6 Day Capricorn Coast Rail & Drive Discovery

### Day 1: Tilt Train – Brisbane to Rockhampton

This morning depart on the Tilt Train and enjoy a smooth and comfortable journey between Brisbane and Rockhampton. Overnight at Empire Apartment Hotel, Rockhampton.

### Day 2: Capricorn Caves

Affectionately said to go from “nowhere to nowhere” the Heritage-listed Normanton to Croydon railway line has remained fully isolated from the Queensland Rail network and the only line in Queensland still measured in miles.

The railway line today, retains the original rail and sleepers laid between 1888 and 1891. An ingenious steel sleeper system allows seasonal flood waters to flow gently over the line to prevent flood damage during the heavy wet seasons of the Gulf, a design not found anywhere else in the world.

Experience a friendly atmosphere aboard as the Gulflander ventures across the Gulf Savannah, enjoy morning tea at Blackbull Siding, and hear stories of colourful characters, the remarkable history of the railway line and the local flora and fauna through interpretative commentary provided by the accredited Savannah Guide driver.

- 7.2 Where you cancel any booking more than thirty (30) days prior to your departure you are likely to have to pay a fee. - 9.1 For Economy and Premium Economy Seats a total of one item of checked-in luggage per person is allowed on the train (not exceeding 20kg and 180 linear cm). For Twin and Single First Class Sleepers, RailBeds and Business Seats a total of two items of checked-in luggage per person is allowed on the train (not exceeding 20kg and 180 linear cm per item). An additional fee may apply to excess luggage (subject to approval). Checked-in luggage cannot be accessed during the journey, so you should bring a carry on bag containing everything needed for the journey.
- 9.2 In addition to the checked-in luggage allowances, one item of carry on luggage per person is allowed on the train (not exceeding 20kg). The maximum size for carry on luggage to fit under the seat or in the overhead luggage racks is 23cm x 34cm x 48cm per item.
- 9.3 It is recommended that customers check in larger luggage items (20 kg maximum) that they are unable to carry easily themselves. If staff assistance is needed with carry-on luggage please limit the weight to 7kg or less. Please check the Queensland Rail Travel website for more information.

## 10. Items Not Covered

Unless otherwise specified, the cost of meals, drinks, laundry, telephone calls, insurance, sightseeing tours, local taxes, airport departure taxes, aviation insurance levies and passport or visa application fees are not included.

## 11. Package Costs

Included in the tour costs are charges for normal booking procedure costs, communication costs, administration, research, printing, etc. Where the land arrangements of holidays are included in a composite package, an itemisation of costs will not be rendered.

## 12. Visas / Passports

For all holidays in this brochure you will require a valid passport. You are responsible for arranging your own passport, visa and health requirements (including inoculation where applicable). You should check with your travel agent who will be able to provide you with the necessary information.

## 13. Non-Use of Services or Facilities

If, of your own choice, you decide not to use part or parts of the arranged services or facilities, you will not be entitled to a refund from us (provided we have carried out our service with reasonable skill and care and to your requirements) and you may not be entitled to a refund from any Supplier.

Some Suppliers may reserve the right to refuse to carry or accommodate people who, because of a health condition or disability, may require services or facilities to be provided in a special manner or at a certain stage of pregnancy. You should check this with your travel agent.

The laws of New Zealand will govern any claims or legal action in connection with the provision of our services to you. Any claim or legal action against the Suppliers is likely to be subject to the terms of your contract with them, and may be governed by the laws of other countries.
