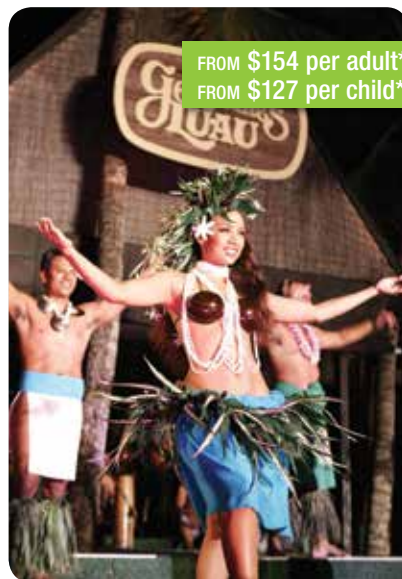


### Surf School Hawai'i

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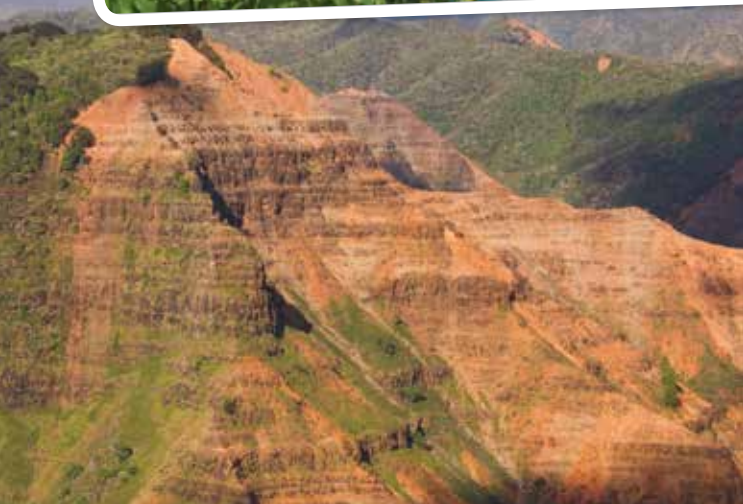
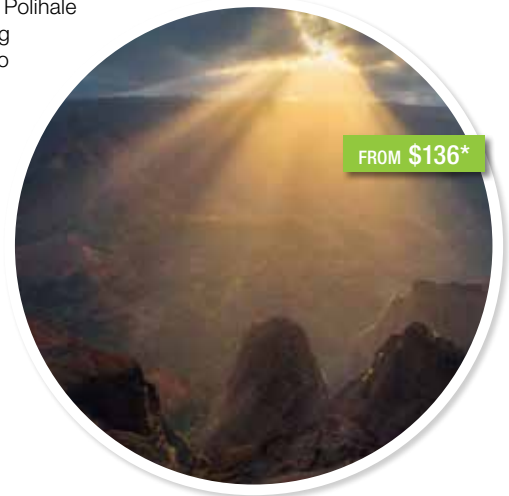
## Hana Gold Adventure – Maui

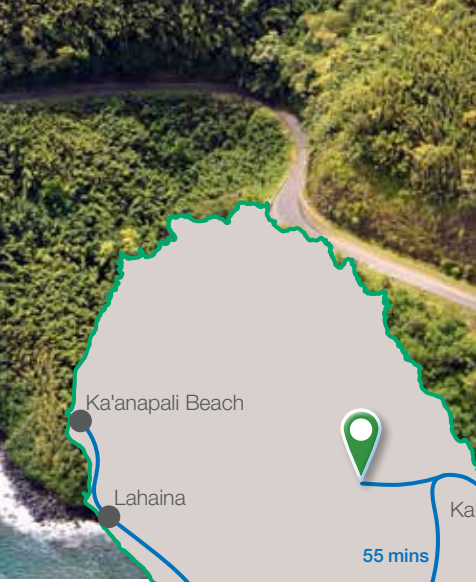
