

For those seeking a 'sample' of what Africa has to offer in a short space of time, take advantage of excellent new flight connections between Nairobi, Victoria Falls and Cape Town. Spend three days on safari in the most popular Kenyan wildlife reserve – the Masai Mara. With a remarkable concentration of animals including all of the major predators, large herds of plains game and an astounding number of bird species. Move on to Victoria Falls, one of the Seven Natural Wonders of the World and Africa's 'adventure capital'. Finish with the delights of Cape Town and nearby Cape Winelands with its European influence and world-class wineries.

DAY 1 NAIROBI

On arrival, private transfer to your hotel for overnight.

DAYS 2 – 4 NAIROBI > MASAI MARA
